

Consent Notice:

Consent is just one of the lawful reasons to process a person's data, if consent is difficult to achieve it is possible to look at a different lawful basis. If consent is the most appropriate basis it is vital that consent is captured according to the strict GDPR guidelines.

- make your consent request prominent, concise, separate from other terms and conditions, and easy to understand.
- include the name of your organisation;
- include the name of any third-party controllers who will rely on the consent;
- include why you want the data;
- include what you will do with it; and
- include that individuals can withdraw consent at any time,
- avoid making consent a prerequisite of a service
